Clap as loud as you can. Celebrate God!

Close the Bible.

Shhh! Freeze! Good job, let's try again!

(Kids and leaders respond). **[Bottom Line]** The Bible teaches me the best things.

Open Bible There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. "Your Word is truth," John 17:17.

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: John 17:17

'Your (point up)
word (open hands like a book)
is truth," (move index finger forward from mouth)
John 17:17 (open hands like a book)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us! Does anyone want to pray for us?

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)
