

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Large Group Week 3

OPENER

(Welcome kids)

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! It's my favorite time of the week because worshipping with you is my very favorite thing! God loves you, and God loves me so very much!

BIG GROUP GAME

Today, we are going to celebrate. I want everyone to clap with me.

Clap your hands.

Yes! Clapping is one way we celebrate when something good happens. And God did something SO good, I think we should celebrate it!

Open the Bible.

God gave us a very special book, and we call this book the Bible. The Bible has God's words in it, and it teaches us the best things. Can everyone clap and say: 'Thank you, God!'

Children and leaders join in.

Let's celebrate God and this very special book! When I open the Bible, I want everyone to clap as loudly as you can. When I close the Bible, I want you to freeze and be as quiet as you can. Ready? Let's play!

Open the Bible.

Clap as loud as you can. Celebrate God!

Close the Bible.

Shhh! Freeze! Good job, let's try again!

Repeat as time and interest allow

That was fun! Now, let's celebrate God with worship!

WORSHIP

Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

Thanks for worshipping God with me!

Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (*wiggle hands*) so we can hear (*cup hands behind ears*) what the story's all about!

INTRO

Bible Verse

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. “Your Word is truth,” John 17:17.

Let’s learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let’s watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: John 17:17

‘Your **(point up)**
word **(open hands like a book)**
is truth,” **(move index finger forward from mouth)**
John 17:17 **(open hands like a book)**

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let’s sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

PRAYER

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Bible so we can learn more about you. Thank you for hearing us when we pray. Help us remember that we can always talk to you—anytime, anywhere, and about anything. We pray in Jesus’ name. Amen.
