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Large Group Week 4

OPENER (Welcome kids)

Hi friends! I'm SO excited to see you today! It's my favorite time of the week because worshipping with you is my very favorite thing! God loves you, and God loves me so very much! We can say thank you to God, and we can sing and celebrate God.

BIG GROUP GAME

I have something SO important to tell you: God loves you, and God loves me! Isn't that amazing!

"God loves me ...

Cross arms over chest.

"From the tippy top of my head...

Pat the top of your head.

"To the bottom of my wiggly toes."

Point to your feet as you wiggle them.

Let's learn to do this together. Say and do this:

Children and leaders join in.

"God loves me ...

Cross arms over chest.

"From the tippy top of my head...

Pat the top of your head.

"To the bottom of my wiggly toes."

*Point to your feet as you wiggle them.
Repeat a few times.*

Yes! God loves you SO much! Before we jump into our story, let's worship!

WORSHIP

Everyone, stand up, join in, and do our best singing and dancing to let God know how much we love Him!

Thanks for worshipping with me.

Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (*wiggle hands*) so we can hear (*cup hands behind ears*) what the story's all about!

INTRO

(*Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.*) Today's true story from the Bible begins with two people in the Bible who lived for God. Living for God means doing what God says and being like Jesus. Let's visit our friends at the Clubhouse to hear all about them.

Bible Verse

(Open Bible) There is a really awesome verse in the Bible to help us remember this. “Your Word is truth,” John 17:17.

Let’s learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let’s watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Verse: John 17:17

**‘Your (*point up*)
word (*open hands like a book*)
is truth,’ (*move index finger forward from mouth*)
John 17:17 (*open hands like a book*)**

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let’s sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Bible. We can read about people like Tabitha and Timothy and how they helped people. You’re the best God! We pray in Jesus’ name. Amen.
