WELCOME

(Welcome kids)

Hi everyone! Welcome to Flatirons Kids! I'm so excited to see you here today!

Show Series Graphic: Like and Subscribe

It's the final week of our series 'Like and Subscribe: Share the Love of Jesus!'

This series is called 'Like and Subscribe,' because when you see something awesome online, you like it and subscribe to it because you don't want to miss a minute of awesomeness. And you want to share that awesomeness with your friends and family too!

Today, we're talking about how Jesus shows love to people in need. Aren't you glad that Jesus cares about everyone? Not just some people, He cares for everybody! You and I are included in that!

GAME TIME

Show Game Slide: Game Time

If you're ready for today's game, I need you to jump up to your feet and find a partner! Once you have a partner we'll give one plastic cup. Then find some space, face each other and place the cup between you on the floor. I'm going to call out some actions, and when I say, "cup," whoever grabs the cup first wins this round! We'll play 5 rounds. Whoever wins 3 firsts is the winner!

(Call out actions such as spin around, jump, touch your head, shoulders, knees, wiggle your shoulders, nod your head, etc)

➤ **Alternative: Choose 6 kids and play as a stage game**

That was so fun! Now let's jump into worship!

WORSHIP

One way we worship is through singing and dancing. When we sing, we're not just singing words. We're showing our love for God and thanking Him for how much He loves us.

Now, it's your time to jump in and give all you've got as we worship! You can follow along with the moves or worship in your own way. Let's sing!

Great work, everyone! I love worshipping God with all of you. Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Like and Subscribe

Remember, we are doing something amazing we're doing this year! We're going through the story of the entire Bible together! part of the reason God gave us the Bible is so we can get to know Him. He wants us to be His friends! So we're going to go through the entire Bible this year so we can get to know God!

(HOLD UP BIBLE.) We're at the part of the Bible where Jesus Himself came so that we could see who God is and what He is like. Today, we're going to look at a story where Jesus, the Savior of the world, stopped what He was doing to help a couple of people.

APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: Like and Subscribe

In our story, two completely different people needed help, and Jesus had time and love for both of them. When someone needs help, don't rush by, you can stop and show love. When someone's left out, invite them in. When someone's hurting, comfort them. Because every time you do, you're showing the world what Jesus is like.

Our Bottom Line says:

[BOTTOM LINE] Jesus shows love to people in need.

Say that with me! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

Let's take a minute to remember the verse we've been learning all month long. These are words that Jesus Himself spoke. He gave an amazing command—something that would show the world what His love looks like.

Show Verse: John 13:34

'I give you a new command. Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.'

Let's say it together! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Each day, ask the Holy Spirit to show you the needs of the people around you ... and how to meet those needs, even if it's as simple as giving a smile. Don't forget: you can also pay attention to how Jesus shows love to you through other people who help meet your needs. Because the more you see the love of Jesus in action, the more you'll be able to share it with others in need.

As you go to your small groups, really think about this question:

SLIDE: Wk 4 Conversation Starter

How can you show love to others? Sometimes showing love means stopping, slowing down enough to notice people who might need help, encouragement, or just someone to listen. Maybe it's the kid at school who usually sits alone. Maybe it's your younger sibling who always wants your attention. Maybe it's a friend who's having a rough time and just needs someone to say, 'Hey, I'm here for you.' What would it look like to slow down, notice people, and make room for them, just like Jesus did? Let's pray before you go.
