



## WEEK TWO – JANUARY 2026 – TODDLERS

**Bible Story:** *Philip | Acts 8:26-35*

**Bottom Line:** *The Bible teaches me the best things.*

**Memory Verse:** *Your word is truth. (John 17:17 NIrV)*

**Series Overview:** Books are a gift because of what they can teach us, but there is one book that surpasses them all—the Bible! Jesus said, “Your word is truth” (John 17:17 NIrV). That’s what the Bible is. It’s truth! The Bible is filled with God’s words, and all the best things God wants to teach us. [Bottom Line] The Bible teaches me the best things! Join us this month as we pray for our preschoolers to fall in love with the Bible and that they will see God’s Word as truth. That they will see the Bible as the place they can go to learn the best things in life, things like God made me, God loves me, and Jesus wants to be my friend forever. And that by the end of this month, they will know they can talk about God, hear from God, pray to God, and live for God, because those truly are the best things!

### STORY TIME

*Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!*

**What You Need:** Bible: “Story Pictures” Activity Pages

### What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today’s true story from the Bible (hold up the Bible) is about a man named Philip. (Hold up the picture of Philip.) Philip was friends with Jesus, and Philip loved God.

“Philip listened to God and went to find the man in the chariot. (Hold up the picture of Philip near the man in the chariot.) When Philip found him, the man was reading God’s words but needed help understanding them. (Hold up the picture of Philip sitting next to the man in the chariot reading.) Philip helped him so he could hear from God. We can hear from God too when we read the Bible (hold up the Bible) and look at the pictures, or when someone reads the Bible to us! The Bible has God’s words in it, and it teaches us how to do what God says and love like Jesus. [Bottom Line] The Bible teaches you the best things.”

### CRAFT TIME

**What You Need:** “Hear it on the Phone” Activity Page; dot markers; wipes; self-inking stamps

**What You Do:**

- Encourage children to decorate their phone.

**What You Say:**

“The Bible teaches us the BEST things like God made me. God loves me. And Jesus wants to be my friend forever. That’s what the words on your phone say. Decorate your phone with the markers and stamps. (Pause.) Great job! [Child’s name], hold the phone up to your ear and listen. **[Bottom Line] The Bible teaches you the best things.**”
