Activity Name: Amazing Award

What You Need: “Award Award” cutouts yarn Coloring supplies star stickers

What You Say:

The words on your award say **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** Use the markers/crayons and star stickers stamps to decorate your award. Then we’ll add some yarn so you can wear your amazing awards and remember that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**

What You Do:

- Give each kid 1 “award” and 1 strip of star stickers
- Encourage children to decorate their paper with coloring supplies
- Assist in threading the yarn through the hole and knot.
- Help children put their awards on.

What You Say:

Jesus can do things that no one else can do because Jesus is God’s Son! Today, we’ll hear a story about when the disciples were out on a boat in the water and Jesus did something amazing! Let’s go hear what amazing thing Jesus did.

Lead your group to the Large Group area.



PRESCHOOL WEEK 4- SMALL GROUP



Activity Name: Sink and Float

What You Need: small, lidded container of water variety of objects to sink or float
 towel/paper towels

What You Say:

The disciples were in a boat out on the lake when a big storm started, rocking the boat. Then they saw Someone walking to them on the water! They were so scared! But it was Jesus walking on the water to them! That's amazing! Peter called out to Jesus and said, 'If it's you Jesus, call me out onto the water,' so Jesus did. Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water to Jesus. But when he looked at the wind and the waves, he became afraid and began to sink. Jesus grabbed Peter from the water, and as soon as they got back into the boat, the wind and the waves stopped. The big storm was over! The disciples were amazed! They knew that Jesus was so powerful and that no one else could do what Jesus did because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**

To help us remember the story today, we're going to play a game called, Sink or Float. We take turns putting these items into the water. We will see if the item sinks under the water, like Peter when he was afraid. Or if it floats on top of the water, like Jesus walking on water. Let's play!

What You Do:

- One at a time, each kid will get an object.
- Encourage kids to guess if the object will sink or float,
- Have kids carefully put the object in the container of water and see what happens.
- Remove the object and continue with the next kid.
- Continue until all kids have had a turn and the group has tried all objects.
