



## WEEK ONE – MARCH 2026 – PRESCHOOL

**Bible Story:** *Water to Wine | John 2:1-11*

**Key Question:** *Who is amazing?*

**Bottom Line:** *Jesus is amazing.*

**Memory Verse:** *“We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT)*

### **Series Overview:**

An all star is someone who stands out because they can do things no one else can do, and this month, we are celebrating the greatest “All Star” of all—Jesus! Jesus is God’s Son, and everything He does shows us how amazing He is. From turning water into wine to calming storms and walking on water, Jesus does what no one else can do. So all month long, we are telling preschoolers true stories from the Bible that teach this big truth: Jesus is amazing! As we finish our “All Star” month, let’s remember what the Bible says: “We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT). The people who saw firsthand the miracles Jesus performed were amazed! And that is what we want for preschoolers this month. Every story we are telling will show them that Jesus really is amazing—He has power like no one else, and He loves us more than we can imagine. So, let’s celebrate Jesus, our All Star,

and pray that children and parents will see how amazing He is in their own lives each day.

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**OPENING ACTIVITY**

**What You Need:** N/A

**What You Do:**

- *Before the Activity:*
  - Gather in an open area and explain that they will be doing a challenge together.
- *During the Activity:*
  - Call out and demonstrate one challenge at a time. Encourage and celebrate each attempt, whether successful or silly.
- *After the Activity:*
  - Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

**What You Say:**

- *Before the Activity:*
  - “Friends! Let’s spread out and do some challenges together. We’ll move our bodies in lots of different ways. Some might be hard, but let’s go give it a try!”
- *During the Activity:*
  - “Can you stand on one foot and touch your nose? (Pause.) Whoa, that’s hard. Can you spin around five times without falling? Ready? I’ll count and you spin. One, two, three, four, five! Wow! Can you snap your fingers? (Pause.) That’s tricky too! Great job! Let’s keep going and try some more challenges.”
- *After the Activity:*

- “Those were some really hard things we did, but nothing is too hard for Jesus. In our Bible Story today, Jesus did something amazing that no one else could do. He turned water into wine. Jesus is God’s Son, and He can do anything. Who is amazing? [Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!”

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**9:20 - 9:50 | 11:20 – 11:50 – LARGE GROUP**

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**Story Focus:** Jesus, His disciples, and his mother, Mary, are at a wedding when the family hosting the wedding runs out of wine. Mary goes to Jesus, because she knows He can help. Jesus tells some people working at the wedding to fill six large stone jars with water. When the person in charge of the wedding tastes the drink, he knows it is the very best wine. Jesus turned water into wine! Nothing is too hard for Jesus because Jesus is God’s Son. Jesus is amazing!

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**9:50 – 10:10 | 11:50 – 12:10 – SMALL GROUP**

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**JESUS JAR**

[Talk about God | Bible Story Review]

**What You Need:** Jesus Jar Activity Page; blue coloring supplies; red tissue squares; glue sticks

**What You Do:**

- *BEFORE THE ACTIVITY*
  - Copy “Jesus Jar” on cardstock, one per child. Write each child’s name on their paper.

- *DURING THE ACTIVITY*
  - Encourage children to color their jar with the blue markers to fill it with “water.” Then ask children to glue the red tissue paper squares over the blue water and see how it changes colors. Talk about how Jesus turned the water in our story into a special wedding drink called wine.
- *AFTER THE ACTIVITY*
  - Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

**What You Say:**

- *BEFORE THE ACTIVITY*
  - “Let’s make a special Jesus jar that will help us remember the amazing thing Jesus did!”
- *DURING THE ACTIVITY*
  - “First, color the jar with blue marker like you are filling it with water. (Pause.) Wow! You filled your jar with water, just like the workers poured water into the six jars at the wedding. Now glue the red tissue squares on top of the water in your jar. (Pause.) Great job! Look what’s happening. It was blue and now it looks purple! This picture helps us remember how Jesus changed the water into a special drink at the wedding. Only Jesus can do that! Jesus did a miracle, His first miracle!”
- *AFTER THE ACTIVITY*
  - “In our Bible Story today, the people at the wedding ran out of the special wedding drink so Jesus’ mother, Mary, asked Him to help. Jesus said yes because nothing is too hard for Him. Jesus had the workers fill six jars with water then He did something no one else can do. Jesus turned the water into wine, the special wedding drink. Only Jesus can do that! Nothing is too hard for Jesus because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.** Who is amazing? **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.**”
