



## WEEK THREE – MARCH 2026 – TODDLERS

**Bible Story:** *Palm Sunday | Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:12-15*

**Bottom Line:** *Jesus is amazing.*

**Memory Verse:** *“We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT)*

### Series Overview:

An all star is someone who stands out because they can do things no one else can do, and this month, we are celebrating the greatest “All Star” of all—Jesus! Jesus is God’s Son, and everything He does shows us how amazing He is. From turning water into wine to calming storms and walking on water, Jesus does what no one else can do. So all month long, we are telling preschoolers true stories from the Bible that teach this big truth: Jesus is amazing! As we finish our “All Star” month, let’s remember what the Bible says: “We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT). The people who saw firsthand the miracles Jesus performed were amazed! And that is what we want for preschoolers this month. Every story we are telling will show them that Jesus really is amazing—He has power like no one else, and He loves us more than we can imagine. So, let’s celebrate

Jesus, our All Star, and pray that children and parents will see how amazing He is in their own lives each day.

## LARGE GROUP

### STORY TIME

*Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!*

**What You Need:** Butcher Paper; Bible; Markers

#### What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today’s true story from the Bible (hold up the Bible) begins with Jesus and His friends, the disciples. (Draw a stick figure Jesus and several other stick figures next to Him.) They were walking to the city of Jerusalem. But this day, Jesus rode on a little donkey into Jerusalem. (Draw a simple picture of Jesus riding a donkey and stick figure disciples next to Him.)

“The people in Jerusalem were so excited that Jesus was coming to their town, they made a special path on the road with coats and palm branches. (Draw a road with coat and simple leaf outlines on the path.) They lined up next to the path, some holding palm branches. (Draw simple stick figures along the path holding palm branches.) When Jesus rode the donkey on the path, (draw a simple picture of Jesus riding the donkey.) people waved palm branches in the air and shouted: ‘Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!’ They were celebrating Jesus because they knew that [Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing. We can celebrate Jesus, too!”

## SMALL GROUP

### CRAFT TIME

*Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times. Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their family.*

**What You Need:** “Amazing Jesus Door Hanger” Activity Page; Jumbo Crayons; Kid Stamps; Stickers

### What You Do:

- Encourage children to decorate their door hanger with stamps, crayons, and stickers.
- Clean hands as needed!

### What You Say:

“Decorate your paper with all these fun stamps because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** (Pause.) Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and the people were so excited! They made a path of coats and palm branches for Jesus to ride on. Some people waved palm branches and shouted ‘Hosanna, Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!’ The people celebrated Jesus, and you can too because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**”
