**Bible Story:** *Jesus Walks on Water* | *Matthew 14:22-33; Mark 6:45-52; Luke 6:16-21*

**Key Question:** *Who is amazing?*

**Bottom Line:** *Jesus is amazing.*

**Memory Verse:** *“We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT)*

### Series Overview:

An all star is someone who stands out because they can do things no one else can do, and this month, we are celebrating the greatest “All Star” of all—Jesus! Jesus is God’s Son, and everything He does shows us how amazing He is. From turning water into wine to calming storms and walking on water, Jesus does what no one else can do. So all month long, we are telling preschoolers true stories from the Bible that teach this big truth: Jesus is amazing! As we finish our “All Star” month, let’s remember what the Bible says: “We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT). The people who saw firsthand the miracles Jesus performed were amazed! And that is what we want for preschoolers this month. Every story we are telling will show them that Jesus really is amazing—He has power like no one else, and He loves us more than we can imagine. So, let’s celebrate Jesus, our All Star,

and pray that children and parents will see how amazing He is in their own lives each day.

### **OPENING ACTIVITY**

**What You Need:** “Award Award” Cutouts, Yarn, Coloring supplies, Star Stickers

**What You Do:**

- Give each kid 1 “award” and 1 strip of star stickers
- Encourage children to decorate their paper with coloring supplies
- Assist in threading the yarn through the hole and knot.
- Help children put their awards on.

**What You Say:**

The words on your award say ***[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!*** Use the markers/crayons and star stickers stamps to decorate your award. Then we’ll add some yarn so you can wear your amazing awards and remember that ***[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!***

Jesus can do things that no one else can do because Jesus is God’s Son! Today, we’ll hear a story about when the disciples were out on a boat in the water and Jesus did something amazing! Let’s go hear what amazing thing Jesus did.

**Story Focus:** Jesus' friends, the disciples, are on a boat in the middle of a storm, and they see someone walking on the water! They are so afraid ... until Jesus says it is Him! Peter asks if he can walk to Jesus on the water, and when Jesus says yes, Peter steps out on the water and walks toward Jesus. But Peter becomes afraid and begins to sink, so Jesus reaches out and saves him. When they get into the boat, the fierce storm stops, and the disciples are amazed. Jesus can do anything because Jesus is amazing!

## **SINK AND FLOAT**

**[Live for God | Application Activity]**

**What You Need:** Bowl to fill with water, variety of objects to sink or float, paper towels

### **What You Do:**

- *BEFORE THE ACTIVITY*
  - Fill the bowl halfway with water.
  - Keep paper towels close to clean up spills
- *DURING THE ACTIVITY*
  - One at a time, each kid will get an object.
  - Encourage kids to guess if the object will sink or float,
  - Have kids carefully put the object in the container of water and see what happens.
  - Remove the object and continue with the next kid.
  - Continue until all kids have had a turn and the group has tried all objects.
- *AFTER THE ACTIVITY*
  - Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

### **What You Say:**

The disciples were in a boat out on the lake when a big storm started, rocking the boat. Then they saw Someone walking to them on the water! They were so scared! But it was Jesus walking on the water to them! That’s amazing! Peter called out to Jesus and said, ‘If it’s you Jesus, call me out onto the water,’ so Jesus did. Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water to Jesus. But when he looked at the wind and the waves, he became afraid and began to sink. Jesus grabbed Peter from the water, and as soon as they got back into the boat, the wind and the waves stopped. The big storm was over! The disciples were amazed! They knew that Jesus was so powerful and that no one else could do what Jesus did because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**

To help us remember the story today, we’re going to play a game called, Sink or Float. We take turns putting these items into the water. We will see if the item sinks under the water, like Peter when he was afraid. Or if it floats on top of the water, like Jesus walking on water. Let’s play!

### **WALK IN THE WIND**

**[Hear from God | Memory Verse Review]**

**What You Need:** Paper plates, Painter’s Tape

### **What You Do:**

- *Before the Activity:*
  - Use painter’s tape to create two long lines about three feet apart. Say the Memory Verse and do the motions together with the children. Ask children to line up on either tape line and give each child a paper plate.
- *During the Activity:*
  - Ask one child to walk down the middle of the lines as the other children wave their plates back and forth to create wind. Say the verse together as each child walks through. Continue until every child has a turn to walk or move down the middle.
- *After the Activity:*

- Connect the Memory Verse to the Bottom Line.

### What You Say:

- *Before the Activity:*
  - “Hello friends! Come, let’s say our verse together as we do the motions. Ready? ‘We have seen (*point to self*) amazing things today!’ (*Hands like binoculars, open and shut.*) Luke 5:26 (*open hands like a book*). Super! Now come stand on the tape lines.”
- *During the Activity:*
  - “[Child’s name], you come stand here. (*Position at the beginning of the tunnel.*) Each of my friends on the tape lines will get a plate. You’ll use them like this. (*Demonstrate*) We are going to make the wind as [child’s name] walks through. Ready, set, and fan your plates. [Child’s name] walk through. Everyone, say the verse with me: ‘We have seen amazing things today!’ Luke 5:26. Whoa! That was really windy, but you made it through! Now [child’s name], it’s your turn to walk through. (*Continue with each child.*) Great job, everyone.”
- *After the Activity:*
  - “The Bible teaches us that Jesus can do anything because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** In today’s true story from the Bible, Jesus did something amazing: Jesus walked on water! **Who is amazing?** **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.** One more time. **Who is amazing?** **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.**”
