



WEEK FOUR – MARCH 2026 – TODDLERS

Bible Story: *Palm Sunday | Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:12-15*

Bottom Line: *Jesus is amazing.*

Memory Verse: *“We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT)*

Series Overview:

An all star is someone who stands out because they can do things no one else can do, and this month, we are celebrating the greatest “All Star” of all—Jesus! Jesus is God’s Son, and everything He does shows us how amazing He is. From turning water into wine to calming storms and walking on water, Jesus does what no one else can do. So all month long, we are telling preschoolers true stories from the Bible that teach this big truth: Jesus is amazing! As we finish our “All Star” month, let’s remember what the Bible says: “We have seen amazing things today!” (Luke 5:26 NLT). The people who saw firsthand the miracles Jesus performed were amazed! And that is what we want for preschoolers this month. Every story we are telling will show them that Jesus really is amazing—He has power like no one else, and He loves us more than we can imagine. So, let’s celebrate

Jesus, our All Star, and pray that children and parents will see how amazing He is in their own lives each day.

LARGE GROUP

STORY TIME

Gather children at the tables to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) may wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: Bible

What You Say:

“Hello, friends! I’m so glad to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today’s true story from the Bible (hold up the Bible) begins when Jesus and His friends, the disciples, were walking to the city of Jerusalem. But this day, Jesus rode on the little donkey to Jerusalem.

“The people in Jerusalem were so excited that Jesus was coming to their town, so they made a special path on the road with coats and palm branches. When Jesus walked on the path, people waved palm branches in the air and shouted: ‘Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!’ They were celebrating Jesus because they knew that *[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing*. We can celebrate Jesus, too!”

SMALL GROUP

CRAFT TIME

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times. Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their family.

What You Need: “Add Jesus to the Picture” Activity Page, Glue Sticks, Tape, Coloring Supplies

What You Do:

- Help children rub glue on the back of the pictures of Jesus, the coats, and the branches, then add to their paper.
 - *I added tape to the supplies, if its better to tape them on for the kids please do!*
- Encourage kids to decorate their pages.
- Clean hands as needed!

What You Say:

“Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. Do you see the picture of Jesus on a donkey? *(Pause.)* There He is! Turn it over and let's add some glue. *(Pause.)* Fantastic! Now let's add it to your picture. *(Help children position and press down on their paper.)* Way to go! I see some branches and coats we can add to! *(Turn these pictures over and rub glue on the backs.)* Press these on your picture. *(Pause.)* You did it! You made a beautiful Palm Sunday picture to remember that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.**”
