WELCOME

PLAY: 2 Minute Countdown to dismiss from Small Groups to Large Group

As kids are coming in from small group, high five, walk around room, and welcome them!

WELCOME IN! I'm so glad YOU are here today.

While we wait for the rest of our small groups to come on in, I have a question for you to answer with the person sitting next to you...

What's the LONGEST road trip you've ever been on?

Talk about it with the person next to you and I'll ask a few of you to answer in just a second!

As kids are answering with those around them, welcome in the rest of the kids coming in and give them the question! Walk around and find a few people to answer.

Ok I want us to imagine the longest road trip we heard of today, and if that was on FOOT. Walking the *whole* way. Yeah, no thanks.

That's exactly what people did in Jesus' day – and TODAY, we're going to look at a story all about two guys who went on a little road trip. And on that trip, Jesus came and traveled with them, but they had NO idea who he was...

We're going to learn all about this story in just a few minutes, but FIRST, it's time to play a game, because JESUS is FUN, so Church is FUN.

GAME: ROCK PAPER SCISSORS SHOWDOWN

Game: ROCK PAPER SCISSORS SHOWDOWN

Show ROCK PAPER SCISSORS SHOWDOWN Slide

We're going to go on our own little road trip, rock paper scissors style, while playing ROCK PAPER SCISSORS SHOWDOWN.

Here's how to play...

HOW TO PLAY:

1. **Find a partner**
 - o Everyone pairs up and stands facing their partner.
2. **Start the showdown - Show Music Loop**
 - o When the music begins, play one round of Rock, Paper, Scissors with your partner.
3. **Winners move on**
 - o **If you win:** Stay in the game and find another winner to battle next.
 - o **If you lose:** Stand behind the person who beat you, place your hands on their shoulders, and follow them wherever they go. You're now part of their "team" and traveling with them around the room.
4. **Keep playing**
 - o Continue until only two players remain facing off, each with a line of teammates behind them cheering them on.

Play multiple rounds as time allows for extra fun!

Last week, we celebrated something...

Can someone remind me the holiday we celebrated last weekend? *Wait for kids to yell EASTER!*

Ohhhhh right - Easter! We learned all about how Jesus died and rose again, because He LOVES us and wants to be with us *forever*.

Now, while that is a BIG part of the story, it's not the end! After Jesus rose from the dead, He appeared to his people and *continued* to teach them about who He is.

BIBLE NAVIGATION TIME FROM STAGE (LUKE 24:13-35): (HOLD UP BIBLE.) We can find today's story in the Book of LUKE, which is in the New Testament (*Flip to the book in your bible on stage*). If you have your bibles, let's open those together now! *Point out and celebrate any kids you see who brought their bible!*

Now, we're going to Chapter 24 the BIG number 24.

Now for the verse, which is the teeny tiny number 13. Nice!

Let's keep our bibles open, and let's check out our story for today.

WOW.

Today's story reminds me that God ALWAYS has a bigger story than what I can see.

The men Jesus traveled with may have SEEN Jesus, but they didn't realize it was Him.

Sometimes you may see the things in your life, and wonder if God is actually there. Sometimes life is *hard*, sad, or confusing. It's hard to see how God is working in these things when all we see is the hard things in life.

But God is ALWAYS there. And ALWAYS has a bigger story happening, even if we can't see it.

Share personal story of how you remind yourself God is ALWAYS with you, even when life is hard.

Because we KNOW God is always with us, and writing a bigger story, even when we can't see it, we can have JOY... which brings us to our memory verse for this month.

Show Verse: Philippians 4:4

Always be joyful because you belong to the Lord. I will say it again. Be joyful! Philippians 4:4 NIV

Let's say that all together. *Repeat several times with kids and leaders.*
