WELCOME

(5:10pm // 9:10am // 11:10am)

PLAY: 2 Minute Countdown to dismiss from Small Groups to Large Group

As kids are coming in from small group, high five, walk around room, and welcome them!

WELCOME IN Flatirons Kids! I'm so glad YOU are here today.

While we wait for the rest of our small groups to come on in, I have a question for you to answer in your small groups...

If you got stuck on a ship out at sea, what is the one thing you couldn't live without, and who would you want to keep you company?

Talk about it with your small group and I'll ask a few of you to answer in just a second!

As kids are answering in their small groups, welcome in the rest of the groups coming in and give them the question! Walk around and find a few people to answer.

Okay, I heard some amazing answers! I heard some of you say you would bring snacks, your pets, or your best friends to keep you safe and help you out!

Well, today we are going to look at a true story from the Bible about a man named Paul who actually was on a giant ship! Paul was on a crazy long Trek across the ocean when a massive, scary storm hit! The wind was blowing, the waves were huge, and they ended up totally shipwrecked and stranded on an island!

It was a super wild journey! But even in the middle of that giant, scary storm, Paul knew he didn't have to be afraid. He knew that even when our Trek gets hard or confusing, God is ALWAYS with us to help us keep going!

But hey, before we get into that, we're going to play a game, because Jesus is FUN, so Church is FUN..."

GAME: PooDeck

Alright everyone, jump up on your feet!

Since we are talking about being on a giant ship today, we are going to play a game to see who the fastest sailors in the room are!

Here is how it works: We have divided our room into three different parts of a ship. Over here is the Main Deck (Point to the middle). Over there is the Quarter Deck (Point to one side). And on this side is... the Poop Deck! (Point to the other side and let them giggle).

I am going to be the Captain! When I call out one of those decks, you have to safely run over to that area as fast as you can. But watch out—the last few people to make it across the room are OUT and have to sit down!

We are going to keep calling out decks until we only have one ultimate sailor left standing! Are you ready? Listen closely... GO TO THE..."

HOW TO PLAY:

- When the Host calls out an area, you must run over to it.
- The last players to reach the area are out of the game.
- If you are the last player standing at the end, you win!

INTRO

Welcome back to our series called TREK! Remember, a trek is a really long journey. And sometimes on a long journey, things don't go exactly the way we planned. In fact, sometimes things can get really wild and even a little bit scary! But no matter what happens, we are learning that we can keep going and NOT give up, because God is always with us!

If you have your Bibles, let's open those together now! (Point out and celebrate any kids you see who brought their Bible!)

Now, we're going to Chapter 27, the BIG number 2 and 7. Nice job! Let's keep our Bibles open, and let's check out our story for today about Paul's crazy shipwreck!

So, what does this have to do with YOU?

Well, think about Paul. He was on that ship, going exactly where he was supposed to go, and suddenly a massive, scary storm hit! The ship was getting completely smashed by the waves, they were stranded, and everything seemed to be going totally wrong. But guess what? Even when it was dark and terrifying, Paul didn't panic, and he didn't quit.

Why? Because Paul knew that even in the middle of a giant storm, God was still with him. He trusted that God was right there on that sinking ship, protecting him and keeping His promises!

And here is the truth for YOU! Sometimes on your Trek, things are going to go wrong. Maybe you practiced really hard but didn't make the sports team, maybe a friend is being super mean to you at school, or maybe someone in your family is sick. When bad things happen, it can feel really scary and overwhelming, just like being caught in a giant storm.

But you don't have to stay stuck in the scary stuff all by yourself! God loves you so much, and He promises to be right there with you through the really hard times. You can talk to Him, you can ask your leaders or parents for help, and you can trust that God is always good.
