

YOUR ROLE AS SESSION HOST

Establish yourself as the trusted leader who makes the message "memorable for kids". You transition the room from chaotic game mode into focused, life-changing listening mode.

You are the bridge between the high-energy hype and the heart of Jesus. You make ancient truths deeply relevant to a 3rd grader's everyday life. When you look at the crowd, you are answering the two biggest questions they could ever ask; Who is God, and what does He think about YOU? You enable kids to experience Jesus not as an abstract concept, but as a loving Father who stands with open arms saying, "I want YOU in my family".

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Command the Chaos;** Run massive, room-wide spectacles like "Beach Ball Bonanza", safely managing the chaos of giant props floating through the crowd while providing play-by-play commentary.
- **The Relational Pivot;** Safely bring the room's energy down from "chaotic game mode" to "focused listening mode." Guide the kids through filling out their physical lanyard cards with Romans 5:8 and introducing the memory verse.
- **Enhance the Message;** Understand the purpose of the message so you can enhance it, not distract from it. Recap the core truth that God is a good Father who wants you in His family.
- **Drive the Action;** Facilitate a quiet moment for the kids to write down a specific friend's name on their postcard lanyard prompt. Establish firm control of the room during dismissal, requiring kids to stay seated for a safe parent check-out process.
