WELCOME

PLAY: 2 Minute Countdown to dismiss from Small Groups to Large Group

As kids are coming in from small group, high five, walk around room, and welcome them!

WELCOME IN Flatirons Kids! I'm so glad YOU are here today.

While we wait for the rest of our small groups to come on in, I have a question for you to answer in your small groups...

Would you rather have to search your entire neighborhood to find a lost baby dinosaur, or find a lost puppy that turns invisible?

Talk about it with your small group and I'll ask a few of you to answer in just a second!

As kids are answering in their small groups, welcome in the rest of the groups coming in and give them the question! Walk around and find a few people to answer.

I am seeing a lot of you who want to search for that baby dinosaur! (Give me your best giant T-Rex roar!) And some of you want to look for that invisible puppy! (Hold up your imaginary magnifying glasses and look around!)

Searching all over your neighborhood for a crazy lost animal like that would be a massive summer adventure! But honestly, losing a pet you really love is a big deal, and you would do whatever it takes to find them, right?

Well, today we are continuing our epic summer adventure called Kingdom Quest! Jesus is going to tell us a story about a guy who loses an animal that is super important to him, and the wild rescue mission he goes on to get it back. And the best part is, this story shows us exactly how much God loves YOU!

But hey, before we get into that, we're going to play a game, because Jesus is FUN, so Church is FUN...

Alright everyone, it is game time! Can you believe we have already been in our brand new rooms for a couple of weeks?

Since we are all still getting to know each other and making new friends in this room, I thought it would be fun to find out what you guys really love. And what is the absolute best thing to talk about? SWEET TREATS!

We are going to play a massive game of **Would You Rather: Sweet Treats Edition!**

Here is how we play: I am going to give you two delicious choices. If you would choose the FIRST treat, you are going to safely move to THIS side of the room! (Point to the left side).

But, if you would choose the SECOND treat, you are going to safely move to THAT side of the room! (Point to the right side).

Once you get to your side, look around at all the kids standing with you—these are your new sweet-treat best friends! I want you to give someone next to you a high-five.

Here is the only rule: We have to move quickly, but safely! No pushing, no tackling, and no sliding on your knees!

Are you guys ready? Let's get everybody standing right here in the middle to start. (Wait for kids to stand up and gather).

Alright, here is your very first question...

PRO-TIP FOR THE HOST: Between rounds, you can have them do a fun movement back to the middle of the room (e.g., "Alright, tip-toe back to the middle!" or "Hop on one foot back to the center!") to keep the energy controlled before the next question!

I love worshipping with you guys, and God loves it EVEN MORE. Let's take a seat and get ready for our bible story together.

INTRO

Wow! Great job singing and dancing, everyone! You guys can go ahead and grab a seat.

We are officially in week two of our epic summer adventure called Kingdom Quest! Remember, for this series we are acting like explorers to search for hidden treasures in special stories Jesus told—called parables. Jesus told these stories to teach us amazing truths about God's Kingdom and how much He loves us!

Like we talked about earlier, today Jesus is telling a parable about a massive rescue mission because someone lost an animal that was super important to them. But before we find out what happens, let's find it in God's Word!

BIBLE NAVIGATION TIME FROM STAGE: (Hold up your Bible!) Today's story is found in the book of Luke. Luke is one of the books that tells us all about Jesus' life, and it is found in the New Testament! (Open your Bible to the middle, then flip a little to the right).

If you brought your Bible with you today, go ahead and hold it up high so I can see it! (Acknowledge and hype up kids who brought their Bibles).

We are going to be looking in Chapter 15—that is the big number 1 and 5.

Alright, keep those Bibles open, make sure your explorer hats are strapped on tight, and get your listening ears ready. Let's find out what kind of wild rescue mission Jesus is talking about as we tune into a brand new episode of Story Lab! Let's check the screen!

Okay, how amazing is that story? The shepherd had 99 other sheep perfectly safe, but he went on a wild, crazy rescue mission into the wilderness just for ONE little sheep that wandered off!

Now, you might be sitting there thinking, 'That is a great story about a fluffy animal, but I am a kid, not a sheep! What does this have to do with ME?'

Well, Jesus told this story because sometimes, we act a little bit like that lost sheep. Have you ever made a bad choice? Maybe you told a lie, disobeyed your parents, or were mean to a friend? Yeah, me too. When we do those wrong things—which the Bible calls sin—it is kind of like we are wandering away from God. We get lost.

Sometimes when we mess up, we might think God is mad at us or doesn't want us around. But this story teaches us the exact opposite! Just like that shepherd went searching for his sheep, God went on a massive rescue mission for YOU.

God loves you so much that He sent Jesus to rescue us from our sins. Jesus took the punishment for our wrong choices so that we never have to be separated from God again! Jesus came to find us, forgive us, and bring us right into God's family.

And that brings us straight to our Bottom Line for today! Let's check the screen:

[BOTTOM LINE] Jesus made a way for you to be part of God's kingdom

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Now let's look at our memory verse and say it all together! Let's look at the screen. It says: '**May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven.**' – Matthew 6:10.

When we learn this verse, we are basically telling God, 'Hey! I want to help make things down here on earth look exactly like they do up in Your perfect Kingdom!' And remember, just like that tiny mustard seed, we can do that by making small, awesome choices to love people every single day.

Show Verse: May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven.' – Matthew 6:10.

Let's say that all together. *Repeat several times with kids and leaders.*
