Hi, friends! Welcome to Flatirons Kids!! It's Move Up month! We have kids who are new to our room! I'm so glad you're here today. It's finally SUMMER, and we are going to have an amazing time! You know what, before we go any further, I've got some VERY important questions. Raise your hand if this is you.

Who has already eaten a popsicle this summer?

(Pause while kids respond.)

Who's been to the pool?

(Pause while kids respond.)

Who stayed up way too late because it's summer and you can?

(Pause while kids respond.)

Oh yes, you are MY people!

Okay, last one ... who's excited to be here today?

(Pause while kids respond.)

Let's go! This summer, our theme is 'Kingdom Quest,' and the full name of our series is 'Kingdom Quest—Seeking the Greatest Treasure.' We're going to discover some pretty amazing stories Jesus told that help us learn about God's kingdom. I'm so excited!

To get us started, we're going to play a game

How does God's kingdom grow? It grows when more and more people decide to follow Jesus, the King!

And that's the way God wants it! God wants His kingdom to grow and grow and grow! He wants more and more people to accept Jesus' payment for their sins and follow Him as King.

I'm so glad Jesus taught us this about God's kingdom. There's so much we wouldn't know about God's kingdom unless Jesus told us! You see, Jesus is God, and He came from where God lives. While Jesus was on earth, He taught us about things of God. He came and taught us about God's kingdom.

That's exactly what our Bottom Line for this week says. Let's check it out:

[Bottom Line] Jesus shows us God's kingdom.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

God's kingdom is still growing now! It was growing a long time ago, and it still is today. And you are a part of this kingdom!

As a follower of Jesus, the King, you don't have to grow God's kingdom. That's God's job. But you can point to it! When you're kind to someone who is lonely on the playground, you're pointing to Jesus and saying, 'Hey, the King of this kingdom is kind like this!' When you make a card for a neighbor who is sick, you're pointing to Jesus and saying, 'Hey, the King of this kingdom is thoughtful, just like this!'

You can point them to Jesus and maybe, just maybe, if they ask why you're acting that way, you can say, 'Well, I'm trying to be just like King Jesus! He is the King of this kingdom you can be a part of because He loves you too!' God's kingdom grows and grows as more people join it and begin their forever friendship with Jesus, the King. You are a part of that kingdom, and you can point to it!

Our Memory Verse this month is a prayer to help us remember this! It's Matthew 6:10!

Hey, everyone! Welcome to Flatirons Kids! I'm so glad you're here today. If this is your first time, welcome! You picked a great day to join us because we're continuing our summer Kingdom Quest! The full name of our series this month is 'Kingdom Quest—Seeking the Greatest Treasure,' and today is going to be awesome.

We're spending this summer learning about God's kingdom. God is loving, joyful, kind, good, just, and honest—among other things. And God's kingdom is where He reigns, and where those characteristics are the way things operate! God's kingdom is a great, great place!

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GAME TIME

Before we jump into anything, we've got to get our bodies and brains warmed up. Everybody, stand up! "Alright, first warm-up: speed hands. When I say, 'GO!' clap as fast as you can for three seconds. Ready ... GO!

(Pause while kids clap.)

Freeze! Nice!

Next warm-up: quick feet. Everybody, march in place like you're sprinting across a castle bridge ... faster ... faster ... aaand FREEZE!

Last warm-up: Let me see some quick reflexes!

Point to the ceiling!

Point to the floor!

Point to your elbow!

Point to someone wearing blue!

Point to your imaginary treasure chest!

Yes! Reflexes unlocked.

And now ... for the final warm-up test. When I say, 'KINGDOM,' you say, 'QUEST.' Ready?
"KINGDOM!"

(kids respond) "QUEST!"

Even louder! KINGDOM!"

(kids respond) "QUEST!"

HOST: "Perfect. You're officially ready. You guys can go ahead and take a seat.

That was fun! You all did great! You can go back to your seats now.

What an amazing story Jesus told. A shepherd with one hundred sheep ... and when just one wandered away, he didn't shrug or give up. He went searching. He kept looking. He didn't stop until he found the one that was lost.

And when he found that sheep? He didn't fuss at it or send it back alone. He scooped it up, carried it home, and told everyone, 'Come celebrate with me!' The shepherd wasn't just happy—he was over-the-moon joyful.

And Jesus said that's what God is like. God wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. God wants everyone to be close to Him. But sin keeps us from being close to God. Every single person had the same need. Every single person had a sin problem.

Jesus did what we needed to make a way for us to come back to God. He paid the price for our sin. Jesus paid the price to bring us back to God. We were all lost, but Jesus made a way for all of us to come back home to Him and be God's forever friend! Anyone can choose to accept what He did on the cross. Jesus made it possible for us to be a part of God's kingdom!

That's how big God's love is. That's how big God's heart is. And that's why Jesus told this story—to show us that every single person matters to God, and heaven rejoices when someone is found!

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Let's look at our Memory Verse for this month. This verse is actually part of a big prayer Jesus taught to His followers so they would know how to pray. Sometimes we don't know what to say when we talk to God. But Jesus gave us these words to help us. I'll read it first, then we'll say it together!

Show Verse: Matthew 6:10 NIRV

May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven.

Say that with me! (Repeat several times with kids and leaders)

Great job. And remember, this isn't just a verse to memorize. It's a prayer you can pray anywhere, anytime. God's kingdom, where He reigns, is amazing, amazing, amazing. God is good, and His kingdom is so good! And God wants His kingdom—His goodness and His ways—to show up in your life and in the world around you. When we pray this verse, we're asking God to bring His kingdom more to our world.

Let's take a few moments to be quiet and let our hearts be still while we pray. Everyone take a deep breath ... and let it out. That's great. Now let's pray.

Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us the way the shepherd loved His sheep. Thank you for coming to find us when we were lost. Thank You for making a way for us to come home to God's kingdom. Help us stay close to You, trust You, and follow You every day. We love you so much. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Hey, everybody! Welcome to another awesome day here at Flatirons Kids! I'm really glad you're here today. This room is better with you in it!

Show Series Graphic: Kingdom Quest

This summer, we're on a Kingdom Quest! We've been learning about God's kingdom all month long. The full title of our series this month is 'Kingdom Quest—Seeking the Greatest Treasure.'

God is good, kind, just, trustworthy, and patient, and His kingdom is anywhere where He reigns.

We're going to get started on our journey of learning about God's kingdom, but before we jump in, let's get our bodies and brains ready. Go ahead and stand up in your spot.

Let's take a deep breath in ... and let it out. Nice. Now let's wake up our bodies a little. When I count to three, I want you to do one big jump. Ready? One ... two ... three!

(Pause while kids jump.)

Great job! Now let's do a stretch. (Demonstrate the stretches as you say them.) Reach your hands high toward the ceiling ... hold them there... and bring them back down. Perfect!

Last thing, give three people you don't know a high-five.

(Pause while kids high-five each other.)

Great job, everyone! Before we get started, we love to have fun here in Kids Min, so let's play a game!

GAME TIME

Show Slide: Reverse Charades

We're going to play a game we like to call 'Reverse Charades'. It's a lot like regular charades, but instead of one person acting something out and everyone else guessing, you all will act something out; I will try to guess the answer. Got it? Are you ready?

You'll see something on the screen. I won't look. Do not say what it is!! Just look at the picture and start acting it out. I'll do my best to guess what you are acting out. Let's play!

Show picture on the screen without peeking. Play as many rounds as time allows

That was so fun! Before we get to our Bible lesson, let's prepare our hearts to worship.

Some people were like the older son—they followed all the rules and worked hard, but forgot that God's love is a gift, not something we earn. Jesus wanted them to know that God's love is big enough for everyone.

Wherever we are, whatever we've done, whether we feel near to God or far away ... God wants us to come close. That's what our Bottom Line today is all about!

[BOTTOM LINE] God wants everyone to be part of His kingdom.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)
Jesus wanted everyone listening to understand something really special: God's love doesn't stop. God's love doesn't run out. And God's love doesn't play favorites. We can remember that God loves us no matter what. We can come close to God anytime. And we can show God's love to others because in God's kingdom, there is always room for everyone.

Our priceless treasure is knowing God and living in His kingdom. Sometimes, we might think other things are more important—our toys, our games, our plans, or the things we want. Those things might not be bad. It's okay to like your toys or want certain things.

But Jesus tells us these stories to remind us: God's love is the greatest treasure we could ever have. When we put God first and choose to follow Him, we find something better than anything we could buy or own. Since God wants to be your closest friend, treat Him like the most important one by talking to Him all day about everything.
