INTRO and GAME

Show Series Graphic: Kingdom Quest

Today's true story from the Bible is from the book of Luke. Jesus tells a story about a Father and 2 sons that he loves. One son runs far away.

When I say 'Go,' I want you to run in place as fast as you can (**demonstrate**)

When I say 'Freeze', stop running and give yourself a big hug (**demonstrate**)

Ready, let's play!

Go! (**run in place**)

Freeze! (**hug yourself**)

(Repeat several times.)

That was fun! Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (**wiggle hands**) so we can hear (**cup hands behind ears**) what the story's all about! Let's visit Ollie and our friends at the clubhouse and hear our true story from the Bible!

Bible Verse

(Open Bible) Now, let's learn some of God's words from the Bible.

Let's learn this together! Everyone, stand up! Are you ready? Let's watch the motions, then we can do them all together!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: Matthew 6:10

“Your kingdom come (**point up**)
your will be done, (**hold hands out, palms up**)
on earth (**point down**)
as it is in heaven” (**point up**)

Matthew 6:10 NIV. (Open hands like a book.)

(Practice verse a couple of times using whisper voices, silly voices, loud voices, slow, fast, etc.)

Great job, everybody! Now, let's sit down, bow our heads, and talk to God because He loves us!

(Have kids sit back down, get quiet, fold their hands, and close their eyes.)

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You so much for loving us. You love everyone, not just a few people. Help us to love people the way You love them, so we can all be a part of Your kingdom. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
