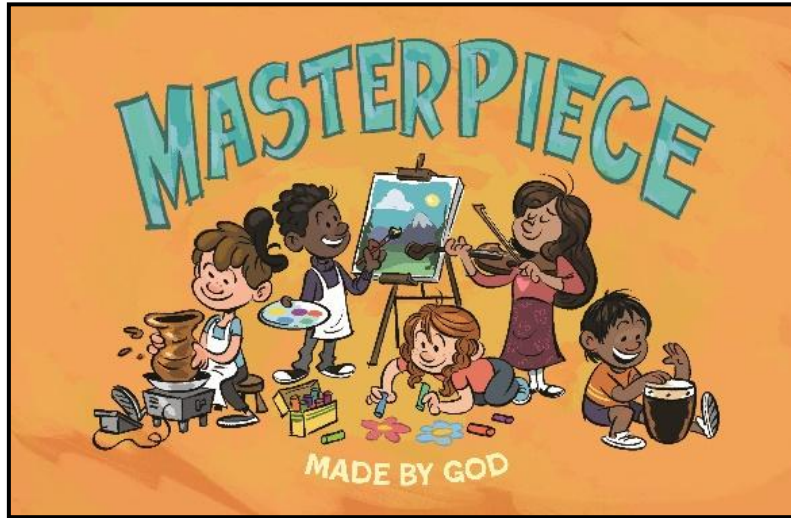




Bible Story: Image of God • *Genesis 1:26-30; Colossians 1:15*

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WELCOME

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Hi, friends! I'm so excited you're here today! This is the first week of our 'Masterpiece' series. The full name of our series this month is 'Masterpiece—Made by God,' and over the next few weeks, we're going to explore how God made each of us as His very own masterpiece full of purpose!

"Who here loves to create? Maybe you like drawing, painting, crafts, or building things! Raise your hand if that's you.

(Pause while kids raise their hands.)

Wow, look at all those hands! That's a lot of creatives in one room!

GAME TIME

Let's have some fun to get our creativity flowing. I'm going to say a word, and you have five seconds to act it out or make a pose. You can use your hands, your arms, your face, anything you want! Ready?

First word ... painting! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

Great! Next word ... sculpture! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

Next ... music! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

Next ... photographer! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

Next ... dancer! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

And last one ... drawing! 5...4...3...2...1, pose! *(Kids pose.)*

That was amazing and also hilarious. Great job, artists. Thanks for playing! Let's get ready to worship together!

WORSHIP

You know, worship is one of the best things we get to do together. It's a chance to sing, move, and thank God just for being who He is. You don't have to sing perfectly. You don't even have to know all the moves. It's more about us coming together and saying, 'I love You, God. You are number one in my life!' Let's sing!

Show Worship: 2 songs

I love hearing you sing and seeing you worship God. When we worship, we're reminding our hearts that God is good, and He's always with us.

Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

We're starting a brand-new theme, and it's called 'Masterpiece—Made by God.' This whole month, we're going to talk about how you are a great creation of God! His masterpiece!

(HOLD UP BIBLE.) Today's true story from the Bible is in the book of Genesis, chapter 1. God made plants and trees. God made fish, birds, and animals. And after God made all of it, the Bible tells us it was good. Now here's the moment I want you to really lean in for... because God wasn't done yet. Let's check out our video!

APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Today, we learned some really important truths about God and ourselves. First, God made people to reflect Him. Being made in God's image is so special.

Then we learned that Jesus shows us exactly what God is like. He is the perfect picture of God. Because of what Jesus did on the cross, taking the punishment for our sin, we can be forgiven and have a relationship with God, and His image can now be clearer in our lives.

God made each of us amazing and wonderful. Even though sin sometimes makes it harder to reflect God perfectly, God's love and design for us never change. He made us with care, and He is proud of what He made.

Our Bottom Line today talks about this too. Let's see what it says.

[Bottom Line] I am made in the image of God.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Did you know there's a verse in the Bible that talks about how amazing you are? Not because of what you wear or how fast you can run, but because of how God made you. God made you on purpose, and He made you wonderfully.

That's what our Memory Verse is all about this month! It's Psalm 139:14.

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14 NIV

How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well. Psalm 139:14 NIV

Now, I'll lead you through each part. Repeat after me, nice and loud!

(Repeat verse several times with kids and leaders)

Great job! Before we go to our small groups, let's talk to God together, friends. You can bow your heads and close your eyes.

PRAYER

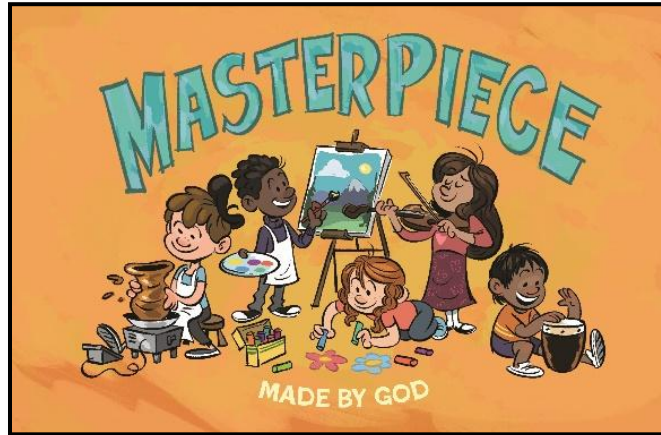
(or invite a kid to pray for your group)

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WELCOME

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Hey, everyone! Welcome to Flatirons Kids! I'm so glad you're here today. We're going to explore something super special today: God made each of us unique and for a purpose!

Our current series is called 'Masterpiece—Made by God,' and this whole month, we're going to learn about how we're God's masterpiece—His most special and favorite creation!

But before we dive in today, let's get our bodies and minds moving!

GAME TIME

Show Game Slide: Stylish Pets

Raise your hand if you have a pet at home. (Pause.) Do you ever put a costume or a cute sweater on your pet? (Pause.) So fun! Well, I have some pictures of some really stylish, fancy pets. They are all dressed up. Your job is to decide which pet's clothes or outfit looks the best! Make your choice by moving to that side of the room. Ready? Let's play!

That was hilarious. Those were some fancy pets! Great job, everyone!

WORSHIP

Let's get ready to worship! Worship is one way we can tell God, 'Thank You!' and 'I love You!' We can worship God with our voices when we sing, with our hands when we clap, with our feet when we dance, and with our hearts when we remember how good He is. Let's sing!

Show Worship: 2 songs

I love worshiping God with you all! Remember, you can worship God anywhere and anytime! Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Our theme this month is: ‘Masterpiece—Made by God’ and all month long, we’re talking about how you are one of God’s greatest creations! You were made on purpose for a purpose!

(Open the Bible.) Today’s Bible story is from the book of Ephesians, chapter 2. Today’s Bible story tells us something really cool. Even if you don’t know what you want to be someday, God already knows you. God already loves you. And God already has good things prepared for you, both now and when you’re bigger. Let’s check out our video.

APPLICATION

God’s Word says that we are God’s creation. God made you on purpose, and He made you to belong to Jesus. And God has already prepared good works for us to do.

Things like praying for others, serving, sharing, saying kind words, and sharing about Jesus so people can know Him too.

Timothy was young, but he didn’t wait. God used Timothy while he was still young to help Paul, to serve the church, and to share the good news about Jesus. And Paul even reminded Timothy that being young didn’t stop him from being part of what God was doing.

Today’s Bottom Line talks about this too. Let’s check it out.

[Bottom Line] God made me for a purpose.

Say that with me! (Repeat with leaders and kids)

Let’s look at our Memory Verse for this month. It tells us God made us in amazing and wonderful ways. I’ll read it first, then we’ll say it together!

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14 NIrV

How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well. Psalm 139:14 NIV

Say that with me! (Repeat several times with kids and leaders)

This week, remember: You don't have to wait until you're older to be part of what God is doing. God wants to use you right where you are, right now, to do the good works He has prepared for you. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you the good works God has prepared for you right now. They might be small, but God can use them in big ways. And you can also ask your parents or a grown-up you trust to tell you what they see in how God made you, because sometimes they can spot the ways you're really good at showing God's love even when you don't notice them yet.

Let's talk to the God who is building something beautiful.

PRAYER

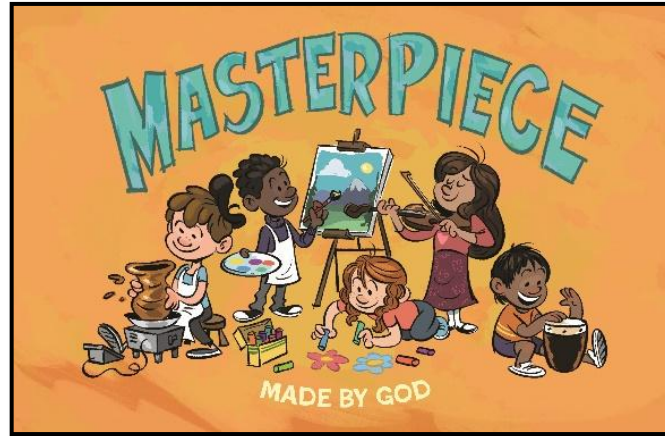
(or invite a kid to pray for your group)

God, thank You for making each one of us on purpose. Thank You that we are Your creation and that we belong to You. Thank You that we are loved before we do anything at all. Thank You for the good works You have prepared for us. We want to pray for others, serve people, and share about You. Thank You that You can use kids. Show us the ways we can be part of showing people Your good heart this week. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.

Singing is one way to worship, but listening, praying, and even thinking about God are also ways to worship. Let's sing and dance together!

Say that with me! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

Let's take a look at this month's memory verse. It's Psalm 139:14.

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14 NIV

How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well. Psalm 139:14 NIV

Let's say it together! **(Repeat several times with leaders and kids)**

When you look in the mirror, when you feel unsure, or when someone says something unkind, what God says about you in the Bible is true. You are amazing. You are wonderful. You are made by God, and He has good plans for you.

Great job! Let's take a quiet moment to talk to God, who loves us so much.

PRAYER

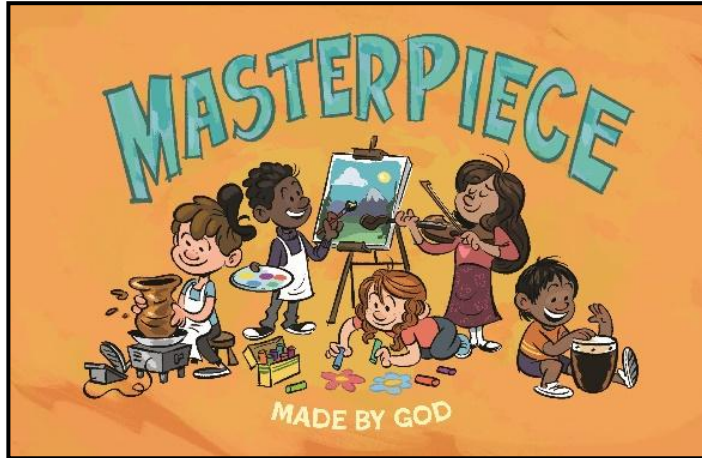
(or invite a kid to pray for your group)

APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

In today's story, Jesus did something unexpected. He talked with someone others ignored. But He listened to her, spoke kindly, and helped her know she was valuable. Even though others may have walked past her, Jesus stopped and showed her what it means to be really valued.

When you wonder if you matter, remember: Jesus sees you. When you wonder if someone else matters, remember: Jesus values them too.

That reminds me of our Bottom Line for today. Let's see what it says.

[Bottom Line] Jesus values everyone.

Say that with me! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

No matter who you are, where you live, or what you've done, you are made in the image of God. God has a purpose for you and loves you so much that He sent Jesus to rescue you.

Our memory verse is a reminder from God about how He sees you, every single day. It's Psalm 139:14. I'll read it first, and then we'll say it together!

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14 NIrV

How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well. Psalm 139:14 NIV

Let's say it together! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

So this week, start seeing people the way Jesus does—with love and kindness. When you see someone who's alone, remember how Jesus went out of His way for the woman at the well. Ask Him to help you show His love! He can help you show His love to everyone, everywhere.

Let's close our eyes and talk to God.

PRAYER

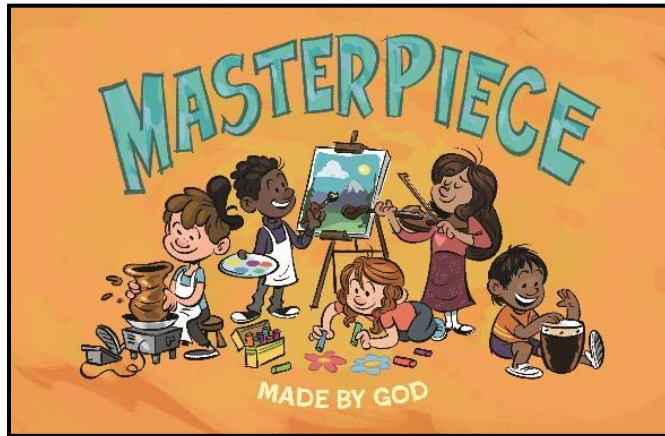
(or invite a kid to pray for your group)

God, thank You that You see every person and love each one of us, no matter what. Thank You for caring about everyone, just like You cared for the woman at the well. Thank You for showing us that we matter to You. Jesus, we want to see others the way You do. Give us kind hearts so we can notice everyone and show that You value them. Help us use our words to be kind and to treat everyone with love and respect, just like You did. Thank You for loving us and for showing us how to live. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.

Hi everyone! Welcome to Flatirons Kids! I'm so excited to see you here today!

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Our series this month is called 'Masterpiece—Made by God,' and all month long, we've been talking about how you are a masterpiece, made by God on purpose and for a purpose. And today, we get to discover how the gifts God put in us can grow and help God build something amazing—His kingdom!

Let's get started by saying 'hi' to each other! Look around the room, find three people you didn't come here with, and give them a big wave or a high five!

(Pause while kids interact with each other.)

GAME TIME

Church is fun, and Jesus is fun, so before we hear today's Bible story, let's play a game.

In our story today we'll hear about some people who were building something special. Let's build today too. I need two volunteers. (Choose two kids from the group.)

You will have 30 seconds to use these cups to build a pyramid as high as you can. We will all cheer you on! (Give each kid a set of 20-30 cups.)

When the timer ends, you'll freeze, and we'll see whose is the tallest. Everyone watching, I want to hear you cheering!

Builders, are you ready? Audience, are you ready? Let's go! Three... two... one... build!
