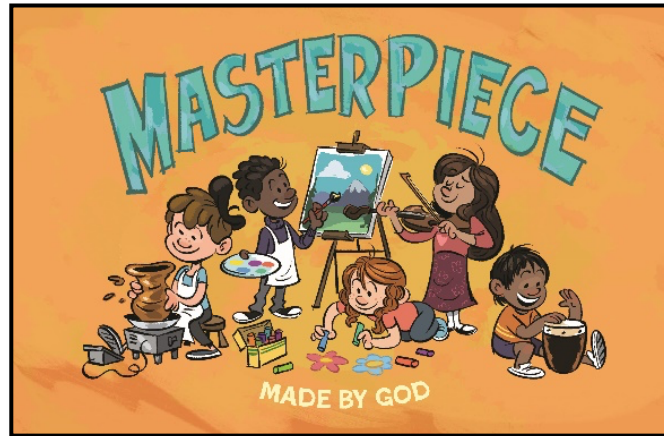




Bible Story: In All Things God Works for Good • Romans 8:28-29

GAME TIME

Before we hear today's Bible story, let's play one more art-themed game!

GAME TIME

Show Title: Museum or Fridge

Museum or Fridge! I'll show you two paintings. You decide whether the painting created by a famous artist in a museum or if a kid painted it and is hanging on mom's fridge. Let's play!

Show Title: Museum or Fridge

That was fun! Some of those kids were amazing artists! Thanks for playing. Before jumping into our lesson, let's worship!

Let's start with something fun. Let's prepare our hearts to worship.

WORSHIP

Here's the thing about worship: Worship is showing God that He is the most important. When we worship, we're choosing to give God our attention, our words, and our hearts. Singing is one way to

worship, but listening, praying, and even thinking about God are also ways to worship. Let's sing and dance together!

Show Worship: 2 songs

I love worshiping God with you all! Remember, you can worship God anywhere and anytime! Let's go ahead and sit down and get ready for our Bible Story today.

INTRO

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

All month long, we've been learning about how we are God's greatest creation, His masterpiece!

(Hold up the Bible) Today's story from the Bible is from the book of Romans, chapter 8. We're going to hear how God can take all the parts of our lives, both the good and the hard, and work them together for something good. Let's check out our video.

APPLICATION

Show Series Graphic: Masterpiece

Today, we learned that God can use all things. We saw how Moses had hard days, but God used every part of his story for good. Paul went through tough times too, and God helped him tell people about Jesus, even when it was really hard.

So the next time something happens that feels too hard, remember, God isn't finished with your story! He can use all things for good, because He loves you and He is so, so good!

That's what our Bottom Line today is all about. Let's take a look at it together.

[Bottom Line] God can use all things.

Say that with me! **(Repeat with leaders and kids)**

Let's take a look at this month's memory verse. It's Psalm 139:14.

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14 NIV

How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well. Psalm 139:14 NIV

Let's say it together! **(Repeat several times with leaders and kids)**

When you look in the mirror, when you feel unsure, or when someone says something unkind, what God says about you in the Bible is true. You are amazing. You are wonderful. You are made by God, and He has good plans for you.

Great job! Let's take a quiet moment to talk to God who love us so much.

PRAYER

(or invite a kid to pray for your group)

God, thank You for being with us when life feels sweet, and when life feels sour. We know that You can use every part of our story for something good. Help us trust You, even when things don't make sense or when we feel sad or frustrated. Remind us that You are always working and that You love us no matter what. We know You made us, and You can use all things in our lives. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen.
