Activity Name: Whatever You Do

What You Need: ☐ None needed

What You Do:

- Gather the children in an open area of the room.
- Encourage children to do each movement the leader calls out 3 times, then say the Bottom Line together.

What You Say:

Friends, join me over here and spread out so we don't bump into each other.

I will call out a different movement, and we'll do it together three times. After the third time, we'll all say, 'God made me wonderful.' Ready? *Let's play!*

Let's clap three times. *(Clap. Clap. Clap.)* God made me wonderful! Let's wiggle three times. *(Wiggle. Wiggle. Wiggle.)* God made me wonderful! Let's stomp three times. *(Stomp. Stomp. Stomp.)* God made me wonderful! *(Continue with different movements as long as desired.)* Super job, friends. Sit down with me.

God made you all so wonderful! You can all do so many things! God made you, and God loves you! It's true! In today's true story from the Bible, we are going to learn that God sees and knows everything, even us, because we are so important to Him. Let's go hear our story.

Lead your group to the Large Group area.



PRESCHOOL WEEK 5 - SMALL GROUP



MEMORY VERSE: Open the Bible with action card inside. Say the verse and demonstrate the motions for the children.

Let's learn our brand-new Memory Verse. It tells us how God made us, and it goes like this: 'How you *(point up)* made me *(point to self)* is amazing and wonderful.' *(push hands up twice.)* Psalm 139:14 *(open hands like a book).*

Activity Name: My Wonderful Book

What You Need: ☐ Bible with verse action card ☐ Prepared booklets ☐ Coloring supplies ☐ Optional: assorted stickers

What You Do:

- Read the words in the book, pointing to each page, and encourage children to follow along, pointing to each page.
- Encourage children to decorate each page of their book.
- Connect the bottom line to the Bible story.

What You Say:

Let's make something special together! It's a little book that tells a big, wonderful story all about YOU!

Let's decorate the front of our book. *(Allow time for children to decorate.)* This page says "My Wonderful Book," made by you! Great decorating! Now open your book to the first page. *(Show the "God made me" page.)* This page says, "God made me!" He did! God made you wonderful. Let's add some happy colors to this page. *(Allow time for children to decorate the page.)* Okay, the next page says, "God loves me!" *(Show the "God loves me" page.)* God loves you so, so much. Let's add more colors! *(Pause.)* Turn the page to the back of the book. This page says, "Jesus wants to be my friend forever!" *(Show the picture of Jesus.)* Look! It's JESUS! Jesus is the best gift God ever gave us. Decorate this page. *(Pause.)* Now let's give Jesus a big round of applause! *(Clap for Jesus.)*

Your little books tell the best story! God made you; God loves you; and He gave you Jesus to be your friend forever. You can take your book home to remember how God made you wonderful. **Who made you wonderful? [Bottom Line] God made me wonderful!**
