

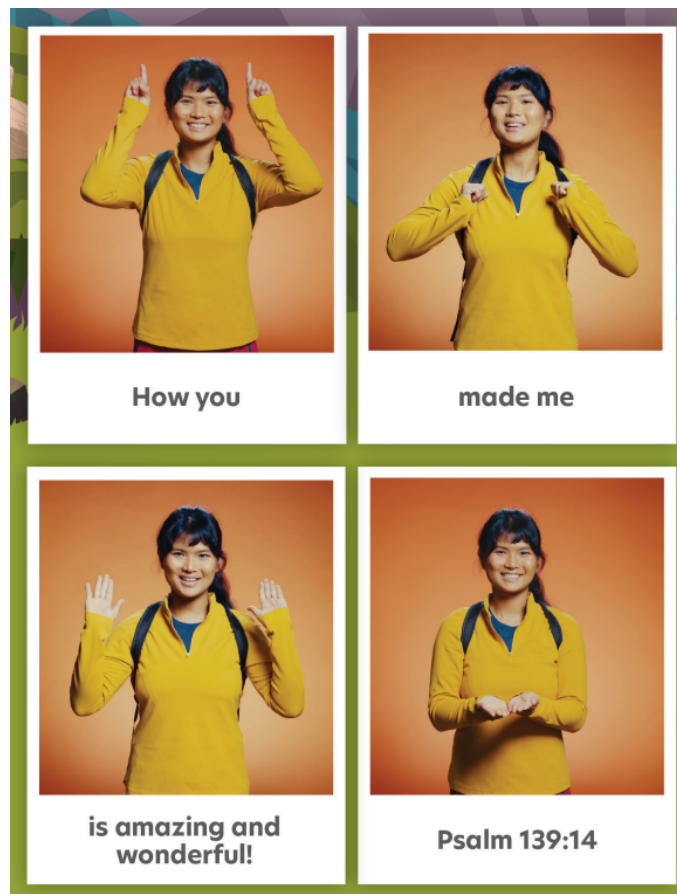

Today's Bible Story: **God Made Everything. God Made Me** • Genesis 1:1-31

Key Question: Who made you wonderful?

Bottom Line: God made me wonderful.

Memory Verse: "How you made me is amazing and wonderful." • Psalm 139:14 NIV



Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom.

WELCOME

Show Series Graphic: Made by God

Hello, friends! My name is [your name], and I'm so glad to see you today. Today, we are going to play a game called "Night and Day"!

God made the world and everything in it! He made the sun (hold up the sun picture) and the moon (hold up the moon picture).

Today we're going to play a game with the sun and the moon! When I hold up the picture of the moon, you will lie down and pretend to sleep (demonstrate). When I hold up the picture of the sun, you will stand up and do what I do!

Hold up picture of the moon and have kids lie down. Wait a few seconds and hold up picture of the sun. When everyone is standing up, demonstrate an action for them to do. Then hold up the picture of the night again. Play several times.

Action suggestions:

-Stomp your feet

-Clap your hands

-Touch your toes

-Pat your head

-Hop on 2 feet

-Turn around

Great job my friend

Amazing! God really did make each of you WONDERFUL!

Now sit right down and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!

(Hold open the Bible) The Bible tells us God made the world and everything in it! Let's visit Ollie and our friends at the clubhouse and hear our true story from the Bible!

WORSHIP

Now, we are going to worship. Time to stand up and sing and dance for Jesus!

Show 2-3 worship songs

That was so fun! I think we are ready to hear our Bible story. Shake the wiggles out (**wiggle hands**) so we can hear (**cup hands behind ears**) what the story's all about.

BIBLE LESSON

Let's hear a true story from the Bible. Time to visit Ollie and friends!

Show Bible Story Video

Let's learn some of God's words from the Bible!

Show Video: Memory Verse Motions

Show Verse: Psalm 139:14

“How you (**point up**)

made me (**point to self**)

is amazing and wonderful” (**push hands up twice**)

Psalm 139:14 (**open hands like a book**)

Let's pray!

God, thank You for making this beautiful world for us to enjoy with You. Thank You for making each of us wonderful and for loving us so much. Thank You for caring about each of us enough to make us different and special. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

SEE & SHARE

Ok, my friends, it's See and Share time! Let's sit on a rug with a leader.

(Help leaders and kids get organized on a rug)



TODDLERS

See and Share

SAY: The Bible teaches us that God made everything! God made light and dark, sky and water. He made the land , plants and oceans. He made the sun, moon and star and all the animals!

DO: Show items to the group and retell the Bible story using the pictures.

1. **Earth:** God made the world and everything in it!
2. **Sky (sun cutout):** God made the big, blue sky and the sun. (Hold up the sun) Can you stretch your arms way up high to touch the sky?
3. **Moon and stars (star ball):** God made the night sky, too. He made the moon and the twinkling stars. (Show star. Allow kids to squeeze the star)Look at this star.
4. **Land and Sea (fish and flowers):** God made the ocean. He made fish to swim in the ocean. (Hand out toy fish.) Can you pretend to swim your fish in the ocean?
5. **Animals (stuffed animals):** God made the animals. (Put out animals.) What animal do you see? (Ask each child.)

God made the land with trees and flowers to grow on it. (Hand out flowers.)
Can you smell your flower?



TODDLER CRAFT: CREATION BOOK

What You Need: Creation booklets, coloring supplies, (optional: assorted stickers)

What You Say:

Today in our story, we learned that God made the whole world and everything in it. Let's decorate your book about God's awesome creations.

I see land, water, and plants and trees. I see water and the sun and fluffy clouds. I see water and the moon and twinkly stars. I see animals really big and really small.

What to do:

- Give each kid a folded booklet.
- Write each kid's name on the front of their book.
- Encourage children to decorate the book with coloring supplies and/or stickers.



TODDLER CRAFT: MASTERPIECE FRAME

What You Need: ‘Picture Frame’ activity page, coloring supplies/dot markers, (wipes for clean up)

What You Say:

Today we learned that God made the whole world and everything in it. And out of all the things God created, YOU are His most special creation. Let’s make our own creation. Let’s decorate your frame!

What to do:

- Give each kid an activity page.
- Encourage kids to decorate the center of the frame to create their own special artwork.
- **Option: use dot markers to paint kids hands and make a handprint in center of frame**
- Write each kid’s name on their artwork
