As kids are coming in from small group, high five, walk around room, and welcome them!

WELCOME IN Flatirons Kids! I'm so glad YOU are here today.

While we wait for the rest of our small groups to come on in, I have a very important question...

WHO IS YOUR FAVORITE SUPERHERO?

This has the potential to be controversial... talk about it with the person next to you and I'll call on a few of you to answer in just a minute.

As kids are answering with the person next to them, welcome in the rest of the groups coming in and give them the question! Walk around and find a few people to answer.

Ok so those are all cool superheroes... but MINE is probably *share your favorite superhero.*

You know what I love about the stories of superheroes? Almost all of them are UNDERDOGS... the least likely people and the least likely stories are what makes the superheroes so awesome.

Today, we're gonna learn all about how God is the ultimate underdog maker, or another way to put that is God uses the least likely people and the least likely stories to do something amazing.

Now before we get into that, we're gonna play a game... and speaking of superheroes, I think it's time we play...

GAME: BUILD A HERO **(5:20pm // 9:20am // 11:20am)**

Game: BUILD A HERO

BUILD A HERO.

YOU are going to get the chance to build a superhero of your own... but there's a catch, you can do it only using toilet paper... I know. Epic.

So for this game, I'm going to need six volunteers. *Choose six people to volunteer.*

Now, I'm going to need three people on one team and three people on another team. *Split the teams on either side of the stage.*

For each team, one of you is going to BE the superhero and two of you are going to BUILD the superhero. You're going to use *only toilet paper* to create your superhero in one minute... think you're up for the challenge?

After one minute, the audience is going to vote on who made the best superhero... READY, SET, GO.

Give the teams 2 rolls of toilet paper each and give them about a minute to complete their heroes. Once the minute is up, have them explain their hero, and have the audience vote!

WORSHIP

WORSHIP INTRO:

You guys got real creative with those superheroes... I love having fun with you guys, and I LOVE when our fun leads us to a bigger message. I'm excited to learn more about how God is kind of like the ultimate superhero builder, using everything for something amazing. But first, it's time to worship together!

Before we worship, can I ask you a question? Have you ever tried to pray? *Raise your hand.*

Ok, now, have you ever wondered what to say when praying? *Raise your hand.*

Yeah. ME TOO. Did you know when we worship, we talk to God?

I love worship, because when I don't know what to say, worship helps give me the words! So we're about to jump into a song where we PRAISE God, which means we thank him for all He has done. We ALSO have a brand new song all about the joy God gives us.

I'm so excited to praise God together - Let's stand and worship!

Make sure you're encouraging kids to sing and dance throughout the songs!

That was so fun worshipping together and TALKING to God together.

Let's take a seat and talk to God through prayer. Everyone close their eyes and pray with me. *Say a short prayer thanking God for who He is!*

INTRO

I'm really excited to dive into today's lesson together. The past few weeks, we've learned that God made you ON purpose, FOR a purpose, and THIS week, we are learning that God wants to USE you, and everything in your life, for something amazing.

I have a question... has anyone ever felt like they have a weakness? *Raise your hand.*

Me too! Like it seems like everyone else is good at this one thing, and I'm just not.

Ok, another question... has anyone ever had a really really hard season, maybe a divorce in your family, some friend problems, maybe a health scare, or maybe it was a season where you just felt sad? *Raise your hand.*

ME. TOO.

Today, we're diving into a truth that God can USE everything, even the hard things, for something AMAZING. Let's dive in to our bibles to learn more.

BIBLE NAVIGATION TIME FROM STAGE: Today's main verse is found in the book of ROMANS. Romans is in the New Testament (Open your Bible near the end!).

Now we're going to be in chapter 8, the BIG number 8.

And now, we're going to find verse 28, that tiny number 28 under our chapter.

Let's find out exactly what God says about using EVERYTHING for GOOD. Take a look at the screen.

Wow. God uses EVERYTHING. The good things in our life, AND the hard things. He loves using unlikely people and unlikely situations for HIS great purpose.

The bible is FILLED with these stories. And YOUR life can be filled with these stories too.

SHARE AN AGE APPROPRIATE EXAMPLE OF HOW GOD USED SOMETHING HARD IN YOUR LIFE FOR GOOD.

You see, just like the underdog superhero we love watching, God USES the things in your life for GOOD.

The next time you're sad, or going through something really hard, or just feel like you're not enough, remember that God will use whatever you're going through for something more amazing than you could imagine.

Why? Because He MADE you to do great things for HIM – and that brings us straight to our memory verse for this month.

Show Verse: “How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. What you have done is wonderful. I know that very well.” – PSALM 139:14

It's really hard in those hard seasons to know WHAT God is going to do with it and through it, but that's where He asks us to TRUST Him. That brings us to our question I want you to think about as we walk into small groups...

SHOW QUESTION: What do you need to trust God with?
